- 1) Call meeting to order at 5:32 PM MDT
- 2) Brief review of minutes. Minutes were approved as read.
- 3) Treasurer's Report:

Checking: \$9,909.50

Savings: \$24,302.00

4) Range Closure:

a) Open discussion on status and future.

We opened on Sunday, May 3rd. Sixty four rounds were shot with 29 punch cards used. A motion was made to operate the trap & skeet field with no more than eight shooters at each field with a Range Officer at each field as long as all shooters maintain six feet of separation. The Gate keeper will help to monitor this change. The temporary Covid-19 rules will reflect this change. Motion carried.

- b) Range hours. Summer hours noon to 5:00 PM Saturday & Sunday. Motion was made to set evening shooting to Thursday nights at 5:00-7:00 PM. Motion was approved and tentative start date of May 11th. This must be cleared with CPW.
- 5) Committee Reports:

Safety:

Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for the range will be reviewed at the June 1st meeting.

There was discussion pertaining to 5-stand. With each start of the game and/or start after the switch of station, the shooter may shoot two shots at the beginning single as prescribed in Chapter 4 "Definitions of a Single Bird" on page 58 of the NSCA rule book. NSCA is the governing body of 5-stand.

Committee Reports (continued):

The question is If the shooter is using a semi-automatic, he loads two shells and hits the single with the first shot, the second shell remains in the chamber. Should the shooter unload the shell or let the shell remain in the chamber and load the second shell at the shooter's next turn? There was discussion that there should only be one shell loaded for the single.

It was determined that this question would be covered in the review of the SOP. Until then, the Range Officer will determine if the shooter is experienced enough to load two shells for the single.

6) Maintenance Report:

Bill Bendl reported the completion of the first clean-up was tremendous success. Bill recognized Warwick Mowbray on his contribution of heavy equipment and one of his workers, without Warwick's help this clean-up would cost a great deal of money. Jim Perry stated that he has sent a written report of the clean-up to Peter Boyatt at CPW.

Bill asked if the club could rent a "Billygoat" vacuum machine to see if we could use it to vacuum up the shotgun wads on the range. He would get back to the board on the cost.

There was discussion about how many punch cards were issued for this project. Bill said he would get back to the board with the amount.

Rich made a suggestion of altering the top panel railing of the "high" skeet house at the top of the stairs leading up to the thrower. The panel would be altered so it can be removed for loading target boxes and then put back after the boxes have been loaded upstairs. Warwick said he would take a look at it.

The subject of new stone gravel for our parking lot was broached, Jim wanted to talk to Peter Boyatt about what CPW was going to do with their parking area. CPW recently did trenching in their parking area. Jim felt that if we order our stone together with CPW, we might be able to save some cost.

Bill brought up the purchase of a tool shed to be placed at the skeet range. It was pointed out that the club is still waiting for a lead test that had been requested by Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE). It would probably be prudent to wait for the results of that test before we make any large dollar amount purchases.

A motion for the purchase of a small trailer or cart that could be towed with the sit-down lawn mower. The purchase would not exceed \$275. Motion was approved.
